


The Screaming Eagle arena includes a 4,800-seat basketball and volleyball arena. The arena additionally features six locker rooms and three additional warm-up courts.



FACILITY SPOTLIGHT

WORTHEN ARENA

BASKETBALL, VOLLEYBALL, GYMNASTICS, CHEERLEADING, WRESTLING, PICKELBALL, & SPECIAL EVENT

Worthen Arena is the home of the Cardinal men's and women's basketball and volleyball teams. The venue seats 11,500 fans and is part of a larger athletics complex that connects the Jo Ann Gora Student Recreation and Wellness Center, Health and Physical Activity Building, and Field Sports Building. Muncie and Worthen Arena has hosted the IHSAA Girls State Volleyball Finals since 2007, bringing teams and fans from all over the state of Indiana.

MUNCIANA VOLLEYBALL FACILITY

BASEBALL, SOFTBALL, SOCCER, & VOLLEYBALL

To enhance the quality of life for the residents of Yorktown and western Delaware County, the Town of Yorktown, in cooperation with the Delaware County Commissioners, Yorktown Community School Corporation, Yorktown JAA Baseball and Softball, Delaware County Futbol Club, Delaware County YMCA, and Munciana Volleyball participated in the construction of a 60-acre multi-sport complex. The Munciana Volleyball Facility has 6 courts, concessions, and a pro shop.

MUNCIE FIELDHOUSE

BASKETBALL

Opened in 1928, the Historic Muncie Fieldhouse seats 6,600 and is home to 8-time Indiana Boy Basketball State Champion Muncie Central Bearcats. In 2017 a tornado passed over the Fieldhouse causing significant damage to the facility. Despite concerns that the facility would never be brought back to use, the Fieldhouse reopened in 2019 with improvements that make it better than ever!
